Staff, treble clef, pitch,	5 taped lines on the floor wide enough for students to
	stand on lines/spaces or to use bean bags.
	(Try masking tape or gym floor tape)
Learning Goal (student-friendly language that can be shared with the students):	
I can correctly identify the notes on the lines and spaces.	
I can map the difference between the high and low notes.	
Students sit around the staff on the floor while the teacher discusses the learning goal and your	
expectations for this activity.	
<ul> <li>Reminders for identifying notes on the 5-line treble clef staff:</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Count the lines and spaces from the bottom up.</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Notes on the lines (bottom up): E, G, B, D, F [Every Good Boy Deserves Fudge]</li> </ul>	
Notes on the spaces (bottom up): F, A, C, E [Notes in the space spell the word FACE]	
Students begin by standing at the bottom of the staff. As the teacher names a line/space or letter	
name note students move to the correct line or space.	
→ Math Strand Connection: Discuss and graph the location and movement of the notes on the staff.	
Extension Activities:	
<ul> <li>Students work together to create 'words' on the staff, e.g. BADGE, CAB, EDGE, DEAD.</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Play various games using the staff – Twister, "First student on the note"</li> </ul>	
Place ledger lines above and below the staff.
